### **BACKGROUND**

Molecular methods are rapid, reliable and sensitive over conventional microbiologic testing in several ways. Therefore, the tools of molecular biology have been extensively used in disease diagnosis, epidemiologic investigations and infection control of pathogenic microbes. The focus of workshop is the interface between insects and their associated pathogens, with particular emphasis placed on, biochemistry, and molecular biology of these intimate and fascinating relationships.

The knowledge and understanding of biochemical, molecular techniques of disease diagnosis is essential among the graduate students having life science and agricultural science backgrounds. Particular effort will be made in this course to provide hands on training about the basic biochemical and molecular techniques on the subject by taking muga silkworm as a model organism.

## **SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES**

The workshop aims at giving comprehensive idea about the basic microbiological and molecular techniques for isolation, enumeration and identification of the microorganisms from muga silkworm. Both insect and hos plant pathogenic microorganisms will be studied as

the model organisms. The workshop is expected to enhance the basic technical knowledge among the participants in the area of basic molecular and biotechnological techniques in the subject.

The course is open mainly to UG/PG/PhD students from Life Sciences (Zoology, Botany, Biotechnology etc.), Agriculture sciences and other allied disciplines.
